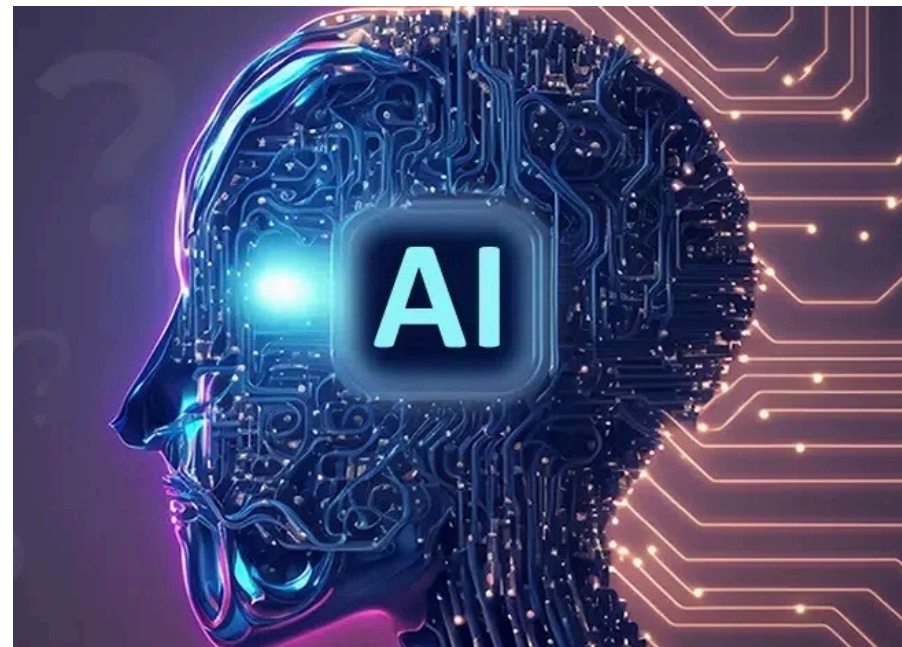
The Beast from the Earth

¹¹ Then I saw another beast ^scoming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. ¹² And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, ^twhose deadly wound was healed. ¹³ ^uHe performs great signs, ^vso that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. ¹⁴ ^wAnd he **deceives** ⁶those who dwell on the earth ^xby those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword ^yand lived. ¹⁵ He was granted *power* to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak ^zand cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. ¹⁶ **He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, ^ato receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, ¹⁷ and that no one may buy or sell except one who has ⁷the mark or ^bthe name of the beast, ^cor the number of his name.**

¹⁸ ^dHere is wisdom. Let him who has ^eunderstanding calculate ^fthe number of the beast, ^gfor it is the number of a man: **His number is 666.**

This is the False Prophet who will come along side of the AntiChrist full of the power of Satan. This is the One World Religion that is makes people to worship the AntiChrist and the Beast System. 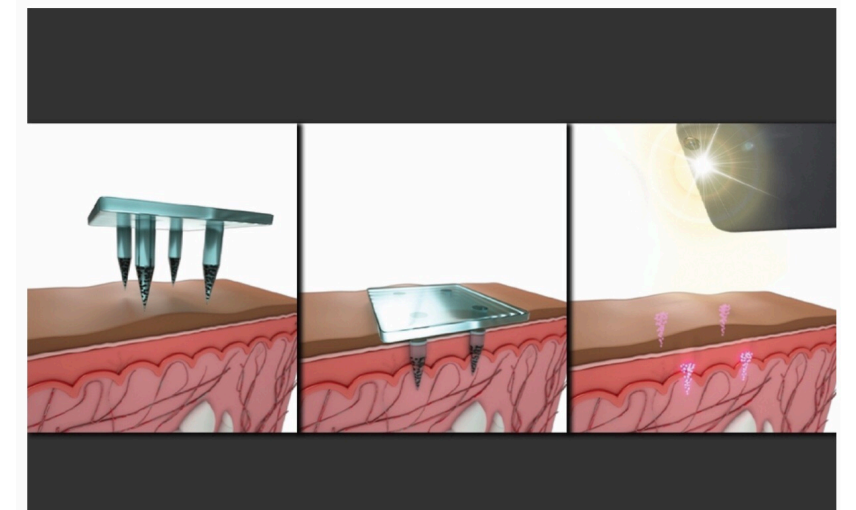

The Scarlet Woman and the Scarlet Beast

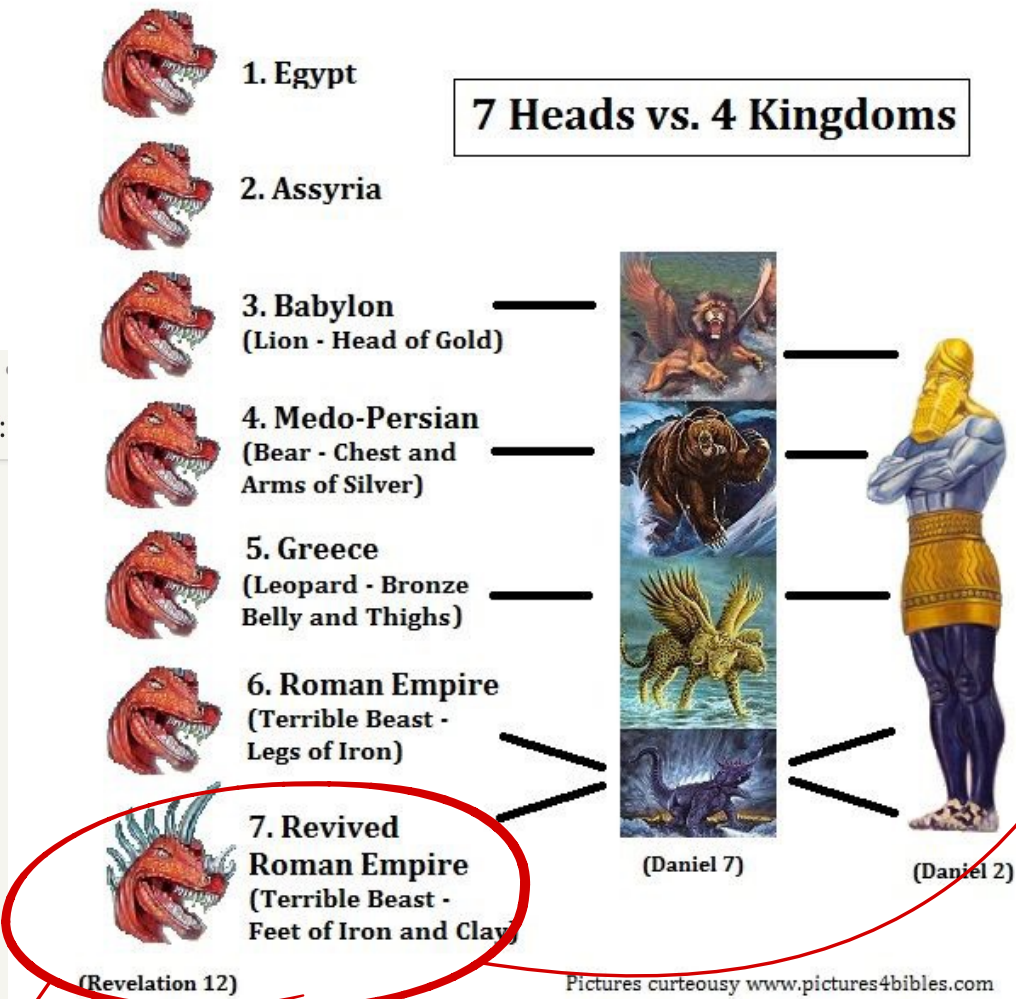
17 ¹ Then ^aone of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and talked with me, saying ^{1a}to me, “Come, ^bI will show you the judgment of ^cthe great harlot ^dwho sits on many waters, ² ^ewith whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, and ^fthe inhabitants of the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication.”

³ So he carried me away in the Spirit ^ginto the wilderness. And I saw a woman sitting ^hon a scarlet beast which was full of ⁱnames of blasphemy, having ^{seven} heads and ten horns. ⁴ The woman ^jwas arrayed in purple and scarlet, ^kand adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls, ^lhaving in her hand a golden cup ^mfull of abominations and the filthiness of ²her fornication. ⁵ And on her forehead a name was written:

ⁿMYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

⁶ I saw ^othe woman, drunk ^pwith the blood of the saints and with the blood of ^qthe martyrs of Jesus. And when I saw her, I marveled with great amazement.

United States = the great harlot, woman sitting on the beast, woman arrayed



Jimmy Root explains this very well, the Greek meaning of the word mountain means “ rising “. When you read, “rising out of the sea”, what rises out of the sea? Continents - there are 7!

So the great harlot is the United States of America and the waters is peoples of the world. The influence that the US has on the whole planet is undeniable. This Beast that she is sitting on is the SAME Babylonian way of life that has just filtered down through the other empires mentioned in the picture above.

MYSTERY - is referring to the fact that the Roman Empire has not really gone away, it has just passed from one major ruling government to the next and the one that is ruling the world now is the US out of Washington DC.

The Meaning of the Woman and the Beast

⁷ But the angel said to me, “Why did you marvel? I will tell you the ³mystery of the woman and of the beast that carries her, which has the seven heads and the ten horns. ⁸ The beast that you saw was, and is not, and will ascend out of the bottomless pit and ^sgo to ⁴perdition. And those who ^tdwell on the earth ^uwill marvel, ^vwhose names are not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast that was, and is not, and ⁵yet is.

⁹ ^w“Here is the mind which has wisdom: ^xThe seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman sits.

¹⁰ There are also seven kings. Five have fallen, one is, and the other has not yet come. And when he comes, he must ^ycontinue a short time. ¹¹ The ²beast that was, and is not, is himself also the eighth, and is of the seven, and is going to ⁶perdition.

¹² ^a“The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast. ¹³ These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast. ¹⁴ ^bThese will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will ^covercome them, ^dfor He is Lord of lords and King of kings; ^eand those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful.”

¹⁵ Then he said to me, ^f“The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits, ^gare peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues. ¹⁶ And the ten horns which you ⁷saw on the beast, ^hthese will hate the harlot, make her ⁱdesolate and naked, eat her flesh and [?] ^kburn her with fire.

¹⁷ ^lFor God has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, ^muntil the words of God are fulfilled. ¹⁸ And the woman whom you saw ⁿis that great city ^owhich reigns over the kings of the earth.”

The Fall of Babylon the Great

18 ¹ After^a these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, ^band the earth was illuminated with his glory. ² And he cried ¹mightily with a loud voice, saying, ^c“Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and ^dhas become a dwelling place of demons, a prison for every foul spirit, and ^ea cage for every unclean and hated bird! ³ For all the nations ^fhave drunk of the wine of the wrath of **her** fornication, the kings of the earth have committed fornication with **her**, ^gand the merchants of the earth have become rich through the ²abundance of **her** luxury.”

⁴ And I heard another voice from heaven saying, ^h“Come out of **her**, my people, lest you share in **her** sins, and lest you receive of **her** plagues. ⁵ ⁱFor **her** sins ³have reached to heaven, and ^jGod has remembered **her** iniquities. ⁶ ^kRender to **her** just as she rendered ⁴to you, and repay **her** double according to **her** works; ^lin the cup which **she** has mixed, ^mmix double for **her**. ⁷ ⁿIn the measure that she glorified herself and lived ⁵luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow; **for she says in her heart, ‘I sit as ^oqueen, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow.’** ⁸ Therefore her plagues will come ^pin one day—death and mourning and famine. And ^qshe will be **utterly burned with fire, ^rfor strong is the Lord God who ⁶judges her.**

¹¹ “And ^xthe merchants of the earth will weep and mourn over her, for no one buys their merchandise anymore: ¹² ^ymerchandise of gold and silver, precious stones and pearls, fine linen and purple, silk and scarlet, every kind of citron wood, every kind of object of ivory, every kind of object of most precious wood, bronze, iron, and marble; ¹³ and cinnamon and incense, fragrant oil and frankincense, wine and oil, fine flour and wheat, cattle and sheep, horses and chariots, and bodies and ^zsouls of men. ¹⁴ The fruit that your soul longed for has gone from you, and all the things which are rich and splendid have ⁷gone from you, and you shall find them no more at all. ¹⁵ The merchants of these things, who became rich by her, will stand at a distance for fear of her torment, weeping and wailing, ¹⁶ and saying, ‘Alas, alas, ^athat great city ^bthat was clothed in fine linen, purple, and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls! ¹⁷ ^cFor in one hour such great riches ⁸came to nothing.’ ^dEvery shipmaster, all who travel by ship, sailors, and as many as trade on the sea, stood at a distance ¹⁸ ^eand cried out when they saw ^fthe smoke of **her burning**, saying, ^fWhat is like this great city?’

¹⁹ ^g“They threw dust on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying, ‘Alas, alas, that great city, in which all who had ships on the sea became rich by her wealth! [?] ^hFor in one hour she ⁹is made desolate.’

²⁰ ⁱ“Rejoice over her, O heaven, and ^{you} ¹⁰holy apostles and prophets, for ^jGod has avenged you on her!”

Heaven Exults over Babylon

19 ¹ After these things ^aI ¹heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Alleluia! ^bSalvation and glory and honor and power *belong to* ²the Lord our God! ² For ^ctrue and righteous *are* His judgments, because **He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He ^dhas avenged on her the blood of His servants *shed* by her.”**

³ Again they said, “Alleluia! ^eHer smoke rises up forever and ever!” ⁴ And ^fthe twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, ^g“Amen! Alleluia!” ⁵ Then a voice came from the throne, saying, ^h“Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, ⁱboth³ small and great!”

⁶ ^jAnd I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, “Alleluia! For ^kthe⁴ Lord God Omnipotent reigns! ⁷ Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for ^lthe marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.” ⁸ And ^mto her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, ⁿfor the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

⁹ Then he said to me, “Write: ^oBlessed *are* those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!” And he said to me, ^p“These are the true sayings of God.” ¹⁰ And

Chapter 18 and 19 describes Mystery Babylon and the Fall. US is destroyed in one hour (one day). We know what this could possibly mean, **NUCLEAR STRIKES, and also Volcanoes erupting. In Chapter 19 we see the mention of the 24 elders, which we know now is the true believers from before the Cross and after the Cross.**

John now shares the Marriage Supper of the Lamb taking place. Again we can see that the destruction of Babylon the Great happens at the beginning of the Tribulation.

Prelude to the Bowl Judgments

15 ¹ Then ^aI saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: ^bseven angels having the seven last plagues, ^cfor in them the wrath of God is complete. ² And I saw *something* like ^da sea of glass ^emingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, ^fover his image and ¹over his mark *and* over the ^gnumber of his name, standing on the sea of glass, ^hhaving harps of God. ³ They sing ⁱthe song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the ^jLamb, saying:

^k“Great and marvelous *are* Your works,
Lord God Almighty!
^lJust and true *are* Your ways,
O King of the ²saints!
⁴ ^mWho shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify
Your name?
For *You* alone *are* ⁿholy.
For ^oall nations shall come and worship before
You,
For Your judgments have been manifested.”

⁵ *After these things* I looked, and ³behold, ^pthe ⁴temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened. ⁶ And out of the ⁵temple came the seven angels having the seven plagues, ^qclothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands. ⁷ ^rThen one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God ^swho lives forever and ever. ⁸ ^tThe temple was filled with smoke ^ufrom the glory of God and from His power, and *no one was able to enter* the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.

My understanding of the Bowl Judgments, they happen after the Mid-point. We see the tribulation saints here singing the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb. Here is another clue to who one of the 2 witnesses will be.

John then sees the Temple of God is shut and *no one is able to enter* till the end of the Great Tribulation, the plagues, the bowl judgments are completed. Where have we heard this about *shutting the door*? The Wedding Feast of the Lamb in the parable of the Ten Virgins in Matthew 25: 10 And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; *and the door was shut.*

16 ¹ Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying ^ato the seven angels, “Go and pour out the ¹bowls ^bof the wrath of God on the earth.”

First Bowl: Loathsome Sores

² So the first went and poured out his bowl ^cupon the earth, and a ²foul and ^dloathsome sore came upon the men ^ewho had the mark of the beast and those ^fwho worshiped his image.

Second Bowl: The Sea Turns to Blood

³ Then the second angel poured out his bowl ^gon the sea, and ^hit became blood as of a dead *man*; ⁱand every living creature in the sea died.

Third Bowl: The Waters Turn to Blood

⁴ Then the third angel poured out his bowl ^jon the rivers and springs of water, ^kand they became blood. ⁵ And I heard the angel of the waters saying:

^l“You are righteous, ³O Lord,
The One ^mwho is and who ⁴was and who is to be,

Because You have judged these things.
⁶ ⁿFor ⁿthey have shed the blood ^oof saints and prophets,
^pAnd You have given them blood to drink.
⁵For it is their just due.”

⁷ And I heard ⁶another from the altar saying, “Even so, ^qLord God Almighty, ^rtrue and righteous *are* Your judgments.”

Fourth Bowl: Men Are Scorched

⁸ Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl ^son the sun, ^tand power was given to him to scorch men with fire. ⁹ And men were scorched with great heat, and they ^ublasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; ^vand they did not repent ^wand give Him glory.

Fifth Bowl: Darkness and Pain

¹⁰ Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl ^xon the throne of the beast, ^yand his kingdom became full of darkness; ^zand they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. ¹¹ They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.

Sixth Bowl: Euphrates Dried Up

Sixth Bowl: Euphrates Dried Up

12 Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl ^aon the great river Euphrates, ^band its water was dried up, ^cso that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared. 13 And I saw three unclean ^dspirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of ^ethe dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of ^fthe false prophet. 14 For they are spirits of demons, ^gperforming signs, *which* go out to the kings ⁷of the earth and of ^hthe whole world, to gather them to ⁱthe battle of that great day of God Almighty.

15 ^j“Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, ^klest he walk naked and they see his shame.”

16 ^lAnd they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, ⁸Armageddon.

Seventh Bowl: The Earth Utterly Shaken

17 Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, ^m“It is done!” 18 And ⁿthere were noises and thunderings and lightnings; ^oand there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake ^pas had not occurred since men were on the earth.

19 Now ^qthe great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And ^rgreat Babylon ^swas remembered before God, ^tto give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath. 20 Then ^uevery island fled away, and the mountains were not found. 21 And great hail from heaven fell upon men, *each hailstone* about the weight of a talent. Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.

The 6th Bowl Judgment sets up for the battle in the Valley of Megiddo. Satan gathers the remaining wicked people of the earth who have rejected Jesus Christ and worship the Beast and taken the Mark of the Beast to go to battle.

The 7th Bowl is the final **EARTHQUAKE** that has never been seen before and the hail the size of small cars are thrown down to the earth. There are noises, thundering, and lightnings, Revelation 4:5 and OT Exodus 19:16. What do we see coming next? Christ on a White Horse with the armies of Heaven clothed in fine linen!

Christ on a White Horse

11 ^vNow I saw heaven opened, and behold, ^wa white horse. And He who sat on him *was* called ^xFaithful and True, and ^yin righteousness He judges and makes war.

12 ^zHis eyes *were* like a flame of fire, and on His head *were* many crowns. ^aHe ⁵had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 ^bHe *was* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called ^cThe Word of God. 14 ^dAnd the armies in heaven, ^eclothed in ⁶fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.

15 Now ^fout of His mouth goes a ⁷sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And ^gHe Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. ^hHe Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And ⁱHe has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written:

KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.



The Beast and His Armies Defeated

¹⁷ Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, ^k“Come and gather together for the ⁸supper of the great God, ¹⁸ ^lthat you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all *people*, ⁹free and slave, both small and great.”

¹⁹ ^mAnd I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. ²⁰ ⁿThen the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and ^othose who worshiped his image. ^pThese two were cast alive into the lake of fire ^qburning with brimstone. ²¹ And the rest ^rwere killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. ^sAnd all the birds ^twere filled with their flesh.

Satan Bound 1,000 Years

20 ¹ Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, ^ahaving the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. ² He laid hold of ^bthe dragon, that serpent of old, who is *the* Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; ³ and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and ^cset a seal on him, ^dso that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.

This battle is different than the final battle that is spoken of in Revelation 20:7.

There is also OT reference – Ezekiel 39:17–20. When the battle is finished, the birds and beasts of the earth are feeding on the dead bodies.

AntiChrist and the False Prophet are thrown into the Lake of Fire.

Satan then is bound by chains and thrown into the bottomless pit, this same pit that he released the demons to torment the men of earth, and would not deceive the people anymore till the 1000 years are up.

I don't have much to say about these passages. They are pretty straight forward.

Christ will setup the Temple and City Jerusalem that is described in Ezekiel 40 – 48. This is the fulfillment of the Promise given to Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and David. Christ will sit on the Throne of David and Israel would live in peace under Christ as King. We the Bride and the Tribulation Saints will rule over Israel and the earth during these 1000 years.

Rev 20:4 - 21:1 NKJV

The Saints Reign with Christ 1,000 Years

4 And I saw ^ethrones, and they sat on them, and ^fjudgment was committed to them. Then *I saw* ^gthe souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, ^hwho had not worshiped the beast ⁱor his image, and had not received *his* mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they ^jlived and ^kreigned with Christ for ¹a thousand years. 5 But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such ^lthe second death has no power, but they shall be ^mpriests of God and of Christ, ⁿand shall reign with Him a thousand years.

Satanic Rebellion Crushed

(cf. *Ezek. 38; 39*)

7 Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison 8 and will go out ^oto deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, ^pGog and Magog, ^qto gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. 9 ^rThey went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the

camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.

10 The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone ^swhere² the beast and the false prophet *are*. And they ^twill be tormented day and night forever and ever.

The Great White Throne Judgment

11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face ^uthe earth and the heaven fled away. ^vAnd there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, ^wsmall and great, standing before ³God, ^xand books were opened. And another ^ybook was opened, which is *the Book of Life*. And the dead were judged ^zaccording to their works, by the things which were written in the books. 13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, ^aand Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. ^bAnd they were judged, each one according to his works. 14 Then ^cDeath and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. ^dThis is the second ⁴death. 15 And anyone not found written in the Book of Life ^ewas cast into the lake of fire.

All Things Made New

21 1 Now ^aI saw a new heaven and a new earth, ^bfor the first heaven and the first earth had passed

As I said in the previous page, this battle is different than the one at the Second Coming of Christ and His army, and here is the breakdown.

Second Coming – Satan and the armies are defeated by Christ

After Satan is released – God defeats the army of Satan

Did you catch that? Christ did the defeating in the first battle and God defeated Satan in the last battle.

Still it is unbelievable that Satan will still deceive people after these people have been under a just and loving Jesus Christ rule.

Now we come to the end of sin and wickedness here at the Great White Throne. Once and for all Satan and sin are destroyed in the Lake of Fire.

I won't go into explaining the last 2 chapters because that is just blessings from there on out and I will not be able to do it justice to the splendour and beauty we will behold.
